

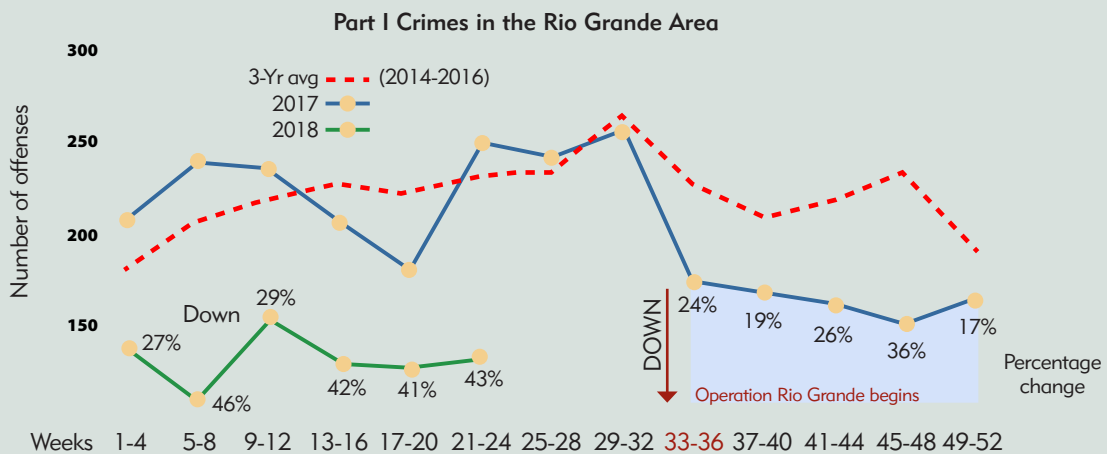
OPERATION RIO GRANDE

OVERALL OUTCOME: Improve public safety and order in the Rio Grande area.

MEASUREMENT: Part one offenses (serious/frequent crimes) — comparing the current year to a three-year average. *The figures included in this graph are preliminary figures for general situational awareness and trend purposes only. Figures may change over time with crime classification and area boundaries.*

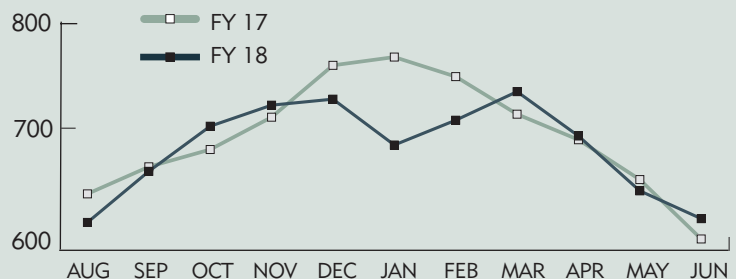
