

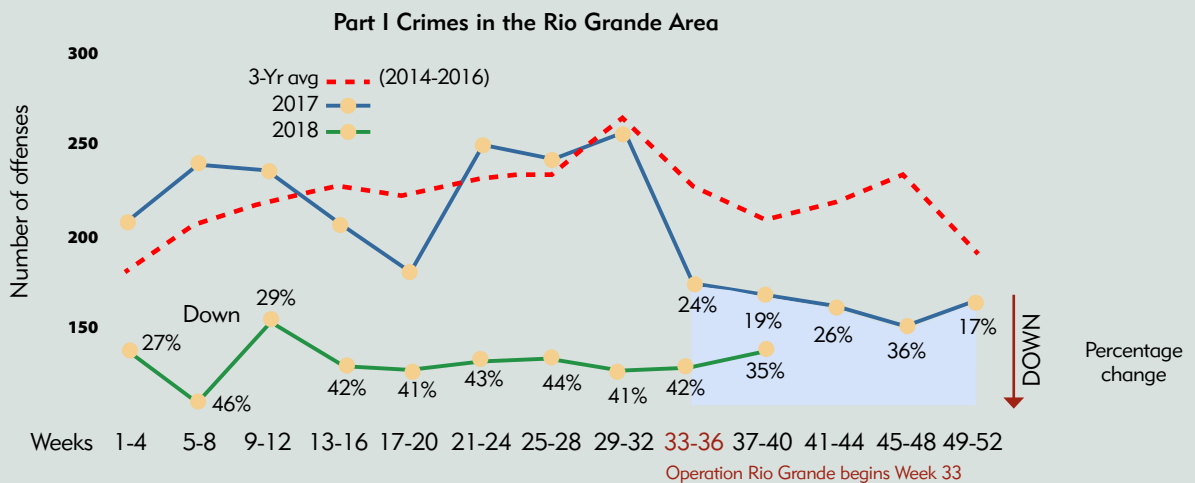
OPERATION RIO GRANDE

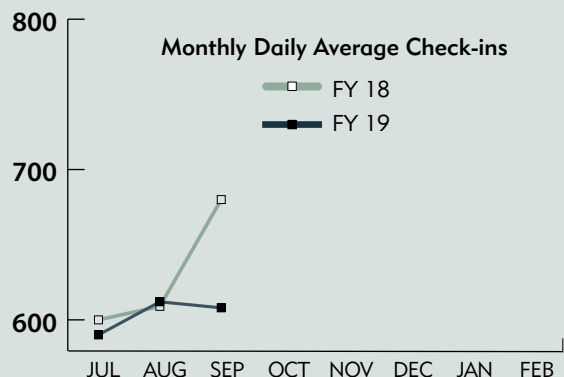
