

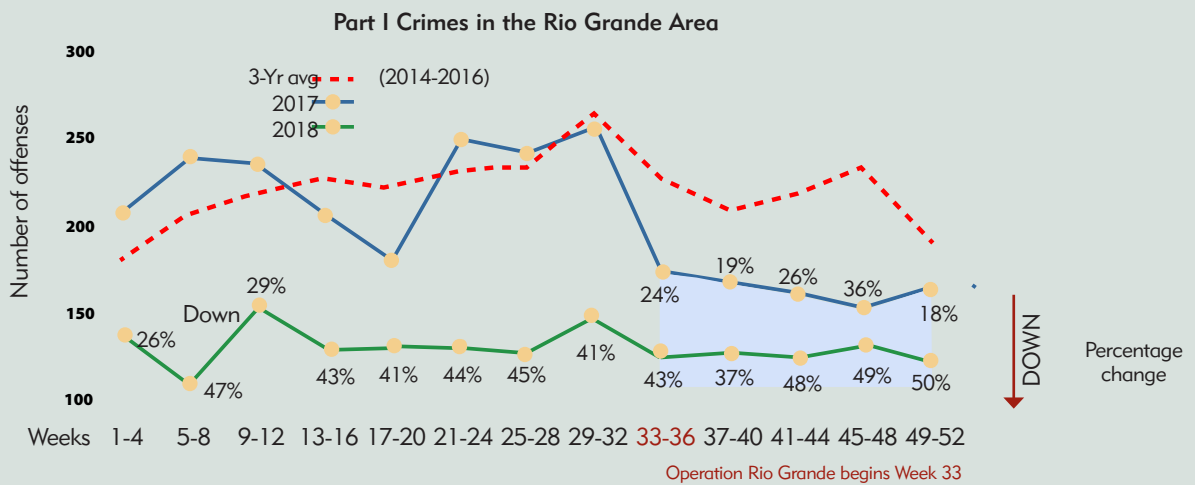
# OPERATION RIO GRANDE

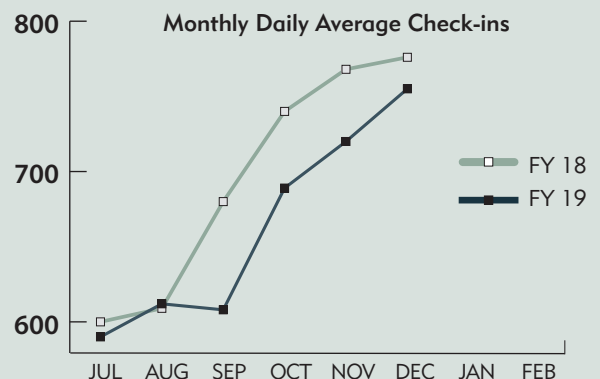
